AQUAWORLD OF INDONESIA



The concept brings together a serene pond and a gazebo with a unique twist: a sunken lounge positioned at the same level as the pond. This immersive design allows the owner and guests to enjoy the beauty of a living aquascape up close, surrounded by the graceful movements of 50 majestic Arowana fish.

Blending architecture, water, and nature, the project creates a private retreat where relaxation meets the wonder of the underwater world.




Nature Aquarium Cylinder

This project features the first private home installation of a cylindrical nature aquarium with nine Arowana, positioned elegantly by the edge of a swimming pool. The aquarium is paired with a striking statue of Zeus, creating a powerful harmony between aquatic life, art, and architecture.

The cylindrical form offers a 360-degree viewing experience, allowing the Arowana to glide gracefully in a living sculpture of water—where mythology and nature meet in timeless elegance.





BALI SAFARI FRESHWATER PARK. ARAPAIMA GIGAS EXHIBIT



Exposed to natural light and set within a lush tropical environment, the aquarium becomes a living landscape—where visitors can experience the beauty of freshwater ecosystems in an open, immersive setting.









INDONESIA'S LARGEST MARINE AQUARIUM

Located at the same site, we created Indonesia's largest marine aquarium—an awe-inspiring installation measuring 32 meters in length, 9 meters in width, and 4 meters in height.

At its heart lies the country's largest acrylic viewing panel, stretching 24 meters wide and 4 meters tall, offering visitors a breathtaking panoramic window into the ocean world.



SCHOOLING FISH MARINE AQUARIUM CYLINDER

At the same location, we designed a monumental cylindrical marine aquarium measuring 5 meters in diameter and 6 meters in height.

This towering installation is home to schooling marine fish, creating a dynamic display of synchronized movement that captivates every viewer. Seen from all angles, the cylinder becomes a living sculpture of light and motion—an endless dance of the ocean brought into architectural form.






TEUKU UMAR MENTENG - TROPICAL FOREST AQUASCAPE AQUARIUM

Located on the second floor of a private residence in Menteng, this aquarium carries the theme of a tropical forest aquascape, blending lush greenery with aquatic life to create a serene natural sanctuary indoors.

Measuring 6,000 mm in length, 1,800 mm in width, and 2,400 mm in height, the installation stands as a monumental feature within the home. The project presented a unique challenge—the massive acrylic panel had to be carefully brought in through a narrow window. Overcoming this feat of logistics and precision made the project even more memorable, turning constraints into a story of craftsmanship and dedication.

This project highlights not only the artistry of aquascape design but also the perseverance and ingenuity behind every Indo Aquarium creation.










MARRIOTT HOTEL LIKUPANG MANADO MARINE CYLINDER AQUARIUM

At the lobby of Marriott Hotel Likupang Manado, we designed a striking cylindrical marine aquarium measuring 5 meters in diameter and 4 meters in height, creating a monumental centerpiece for the hotel.

The aquarium combines artificial corals with natural reef structures, forming a seamless underwater landscape teeming with colorful reef fish. Its towering cylindrical form offers a full 360-degree viewing experience, transforming the hotel's entrance into an immersive marine showcase that blends luxury hospitality with the beauty of the ocean.









THE LEMBANG AQUARIUM - THE WORLD'S TALLEST MARINE AQUARIUM IN A PRIVATE RESIDENCE


The Lembang Aquarium sets a new world record as the tallest marine aquarium ever built inside a private residence. Soaring to a remarkable 8 meters in height, with dimensions of 7,000 mm in length and 3,000 mm in width, this towering masterpiece rises from the first floor all the way to the ceiling of the second floor.


